BODEGAS FUNDADAS EN 1890

Gran Reserva 904 de 2009

Made with Tempranillo grapes from Briñas, Labastida and Villalba plus 10% Graciano from the Montecillo vineyard in Fuenmayor, it is one of the winery's top wines, a cult Gran Reserva aged in American oak barrels, manufactured in La Rioja Alta, S.A.'s own cooperage. After four years in barrels, the wine was aged for another three in the bottle. Intense cherry-red, complex and seductive to the nose, with spicy notes of vanilla, toasted caramel, chocolate, tea leaves, stewed fruit and prunes. In the mouth it is well-balanced, with volume, creamy and fresh, with long, smooth tannins.
