The most iconic wine of La Rioja Alta, S.A. made with grapes from estate-owned farms. It consists of 80% Tempranillo from thirty-year-old vines planted in La Cuesta and Montecillo, in Fuenmayor and Cenicero, and an exceptional Garnacha from La Pedriza, Tudelilla, Rioja Baja, a pebbly vineyard located at an altitude of 550 metres which produces magnificent, fresh, aromatic grapes. The varieties comprising the *Viña Ardanza* are aged separately. The final blend of this vintage was bottled in 2014. With intense red hues, it is fresh and spicy, with notes of cherries, black pepper, nutmeg and cinnamon, and hints of coffee, mocha, tobacco and black currant bonbon. Fresh in the mouth, with structure and elegance, it is silky, with toasty, liquor and spicy notes.
